We are happy to inform you that the "XXXXII Annual Conference of the Indian Council of Chemists" will be held during December 20-22, 2023 at Department of Pure and Applied Chemistry, University of Kota, Near Kabir Circle, MBS Marg, Kota (Rajasthan)-324005.

On behalf of the Indian Council of Chemists, we have great pleasure in inviting you to attend all the functions and participations in the deliberations to be conducted under scientific sessions of Inorganic, Organic, Physical, Analytical & Environmental Sections.

The Conference would provide an excellent opportunity to researchers for presenting new experimental results and participating in scientific discussion/debate in different areas of Chemistry. The conference shall provide an opportunity for a meaningful interactions among the members of the scientific fraternity.

REGISTRATION

All participants are required to register in advance by sending a registration fee of Rs. 2500 (Rupees Two Thousand Five Hundred only) by November 30, 2023.

The registration fee should be paid by a crossed demand draft made in favor of the 'Indian Council of Chemists' payable at Agra or by online mode as indicated in the registration form.
