Objectives

The main objectives of the Council are:

5. To associate with National and International scientists working in the fields of Chemistry and to co-operate with other organizations having similar objectives.

Submission of Abstracts

Active participation in scientific sessions covering the topics of the Conference is encouraged and welcome. Scientists/Researchers are requested to submit only soft copy of abstract (not more than 200 words) of the papers intended for presentation to the CONCERNED SECTIONAL PRESIDENT and CC to Secretary latest by August 31, 2026 from their respective E-mail addresses. The abstract should be submitted online as an e-mail attachment. It should be typed in MS-word using Times New Roman with font size 12. Authors should clearly mention on the top of the abstract, the section in which the paper is to be considered. They should mention their telephone no., fax no. and e-mail address along with their institutional/postal addresses. No hard copy is required.

Note: All authors contributing a paper in the Conference must be Fellows of the Council. (Annual fellowship fee Rs 600/- for the year 2026 or life fellowship fee Rs. 6000/- must be paid along with the submission of the abstract through a draft drawn in favour of Indian Council of Chemists payable at Agra.)

Registration

All participants are required to register in advance by sending a registration fee of Rs. 2500 (Rupees Two Thousand Five Hundred only) by September 30, 2026.

The registration fee should be paid by a crossed demand draft made in favor of the **Indian Council of Chemists'** payable at Agra or by online mode as indicated in the registration form. Registration fee for accompanying person (spouse & children) is Rs. 1250/- (Rupees One Thousand Two Hundred Fifty only) without kit. Accommodation

Limited accommodation will be provided to the delegates at IIT (ISM) guest houses and hostels. There is hostel accommodation available at the campus for student participants in separate boys & girls hostels. Other delegates will be accommodated at ISM guest houses on twin sharing basis. Accommodation charges will be Rs.1000/- (One thousand only) per person per day for the delegates residing in guest houses and Rs. 200/-per day per student participant seeking hostel accommodation. 2. Each such nomination should be accompanied with; a) CV of the person so nominated for the award to be received by the Secretary, ICC latest by 31st August of the year of the award.
- b) Reprints of 5 best publications preferably during the past 5 years.
3. Last Date of such nomination/application would be August 31, 2026. The complete application with all documents should be sent to Prof. Rajesh Dhakarey, Secretary, ICC, Department of Chemistry, Institute of Basic Sciences, Khandari, Agra-282002.
4. Selected candidate shall give a presentation of 30 minutes duration in the ICC conference at which the award will be conferred.
5. The selection for these awards will be made by a panel of eminent chemists in a fair and transparent manner.
6. A candidate can apply for two awards only.

Young Scientist Award

The Council gives an award and a certificate to young scientists up to the age of 35 years for the best paper presented in oral and poster sessions separately in all the sections. Those interested in participating in the contest must write in bold letters "CYSA" on the right corner at the top of the abstract and enclose the proof of the age, i.e. photocopy of High School Certificate. The awards will be given in the valedictory function of the Conference.

Provisional Programme

The programme of the Conference includes invited papers, oral, and poster presentations and lectures by eminent scientists in four parallel sessions, viz. Inorganic, Organic, Physical & Analytical and Environmental sections. Some Memorial Lectures have also been arranged during the Conference.
